


OVERVIEW

The New Brunswick College of Family Physicians set in motion their strategic planning process in September 2020 to build a framework with the goal of establishing a clear direction for the Chapter through research, member engagement, and collaboration. The plan was revised in 2025 in anticipation of what the next three years may look like.
